Awards & Draw Prizes:	 Cookie medals for all finishers for U14 and under 1st, 2nd and 3rd place male and female finishers will be recognized in each age category for the 15 and 30K races, as well as for the U16 and U18 categories and Recreational 8K. Overall winners in the male and female 30K category will also receive a special prize. Draw prizes available for all registered skiers. Bib numbers will be used for a draw for prizes. Pick up prizes when you pick up your bib.

Rules:	Competitions will be held according to the most recent ICR-CCR (Canadian Competition Rules) with Precisions https://nordiqcanada.ca/wp-content/uploads/Nov-2023-ICR-CCR-NOV-with-precisions.pdf				
Facilities:	 A heated day lodge and outhouses, as well as flush toilets, are located near the parking area at the start of the Stake Lake trail system, which is approximately 800 m from the stadium. Portable toilets are available near the stadium and outhouses are located at various locations along the trails. The machine shed near the stadium will be cleared and used as a warming room/lodge for weekend. 				
Parking:	 Park in the main parking lot by the day lodge. Please don't park along Lac le Jeune Road – you may be ticketed. 				
Race Office:	 The Race Office will be in the machine shed (near the stadium). Open on race day between 8:30 am and 10:30 am. 				
Food:	As part of the race fee, lunch is provided for all skiers U16 and up in the warming room near the stadium.				
Wax Facilities:	 Electrical outlets are available adjacent to the stadium. A few more are available outside the Stake Lake Day Lodge (800 m from the stadium). No waxing inside the day lodge. 				
Warm-up/Wax Testing:	 A warm-up and wax testing area is available near the stadium. No wax testing or warm up is allowed on the course during the competition. 				
Wax Protocol:	Note that the CCBC rules regarding the use of Fluorinated Waxes apply. Please see the <u>CCBC Wax Protocol</u> .				
Weather:	 For weather and webcams: https://overlanderskiclub.com/ Cold weather precautions for the event will follow the ICR-CCR Rules (see p. 127) 				
Refunds:	 In the event of a cancellation due to bad weather, the organizers reserve the right to recover costs incurred. Refunds for medical reasons are available upon receipt of a medical note.
